Ways to cook with natural gas!

Grilled Hot Wings

1 tsp kosher salt

1 tsp ground black pepper

FOR THE SAUCE:

4 tbsp unsalted butter

1 tbsp dark brown sugar

1 tbsp honey

3 lbs chicken wings (18 wings), cut up

1 tsp cayenne pepper

1/2 c hot sauce, preferably Frank's Louisiana Hot Sauce

2 tbsp tabasco sauce or other hot sauce

2 tsp cider vinegar

1/4 tsp cayenne pepper, plus more to taste

Mix together the cayenne, black pepper, and salt in a small bowl. Sprinkle the mixture over all the chicken wings. Refrigerate wings until ready to use (This can be done the night before). Melt butter in small saucepan over low heat. Whisk in the rest of the sauce ingredients until combined. Remove from heat and set aside. Turn on natural gas grill so that grates exceed 500°. Turn off 1 burner so that there is a cooler portion on the grill. Place the wings over the cool side of the grill, cover, and cook until skins are lightly browned, about 8 minutes. Move the wings to the hot side of the grill and continue to cook until the skins have crisped, about 2-3 minutes. Remove the wings to a bowl. Pour the sauce over the wings and toss to coat evenly. Remove wings to a plate and serve hot.
